#### **NEW NEBOSH Fire Certificate**

NEBOSH have recently (1 March) launched their new Fire Certificate course. The new syllabus is designed to provide a shorter, more targeted fire safety qualification. It removes the link from N/IGC1 and the assessment is reduced to one exam - a scenario-based Open Book Exam - and a practical assessment. This means there is no need to attend an examination centre.

The course length has consequently been significantly reduced to 48 hours (5 days), previously 120 (9 days).

### **NEW Wellbeing Course**

NEBOSH launched a new Working with Wellbeing course on 22 February. The course is an introductory level qualification that looks at workplace wellbeing at both an individual and organisational level. It is designed for those who wish to gain a greater understanding of workplace wellbeing and the factors which affect it, including people that work in human resources, health and safety, occupational health or anyone with people management responsibilities. RRC are currently developing Online, Live Online and Classroom courses for this and they will be available in the Autumn.

### **NEBOSH Resources**

If you are studying for a NEBOSH qualification, we would like to remind you that guidance from NEBOSH is available in the following publications, which can all be accessed from the 'Qualifications' area of the NEBOSH website (under 'Resources' for each relevant qualification):

• Guidance on Command Words – Certificate Qualifications

This gives definitions of command words and example responses to everyday scenarios and typical exam questions.

(Note: not relevant to Units NG1, IG1, NGC1 or IGC1.)

• Guidance on Command Words - Diploma Qualifications

This gives definitions of command words and example responses to typical exam questions.

• Sample New-Look Question Papers

These show the current format for paper-based, invigilated exams at Certificate level. They are no longer divided into sections but still contain one 20-mark question and ten 8-mark questions.

(Note: not relevant to Units NG1, IG1, NGC1 or IGC1.)

• Open Book Examinations: Learner Guide

This gives guidance on the new Open Book Examinations for Certificate Units NG1, IG1, NGC1 and IGC1.

(Note: not relevant to any other Certificate units.)

• Open Book Examinations: Learner Feedback

This uses the August 2020 Open Book Exam as an example. It gives advice on the kind of answers that would attract marks and those that would not and guidance on how to approach similar questions that you could expect to see in future papers.

(Note: only relevant to Units NG1, IG1, NGC1 and IGC1.)

We strongly recommend reading the guidance referred to above that is relevant to the units you are studying, as part of your preparation for the exams.

You should note that, with effect from 1 June 2021, NEBOSH will no longer examine the following topics:

#### • In Unit A, Element A2:

- European Directives and Regulations (in section A2.1 under "Sources of law").
- The role of the European Union the whole content of section A2.3.
- The European Court of Justice (its functions, jurisdiction and powers in section A2.5).

#### • In Unit B, Element B1:

- Fitness to work standards (in section B1.2).
- Managing long-term and short-term frequent sickness absence/incapacity for work (with reference to PH19 NICE) in section B1.2.

  - Managing long-term and short-term frequent sickness absence/incapacity for work (with reference to PH19 NICE) in section IB1.2.
