## Welcome!

Welcome to our May newsletter, it's a really busy time at RRC with many new and revised courses in development and preparations underway for the restart of trade shows. We have been working hard to keep all of our learners up to date with the many changing NEBOSH syllabi and we have been a bit overrun with responses, so please bear with us. We will get back to you all as soon as possible and hopefully we will return to our normal response time in a few weeks.

## **NEBOSH New Syllabi**

Following the new **NEBOSH Certificate in Fire Safety** and **Working with Wellbeing** courses announced in the last issue we now have 5 more new and revised syllabi, plus some more on the way.

The new syllabi remove the link from N/IGC1 to provide a shorter, more targeted Construction Safety qualification. The assessment is reduced to one exam- a scenario based Open Book Exam.

The content from previous syllabus N/ICC1 is largely retained albeit restructured in some areas. Some sections from N/IG1 have been included in the new course but only those directly related to construction safety.

The learning hours have been reduced to 108 hours (10 days classroom), previously 160 hours (13 days). The reduction is mainly due to the removal of N/IG1.

The UK version is aligned to CDM, the International best practice and international standards.

There has been a significant change with the assessment with a reduction from 3 to 1 assessment. The aim of this assessment is to evaluate the practical application of the knowledge and understanding gained from studying the syllabus. The assessment is based on a scenario (a fictional construction site), is Open Book and is completed at home. It will take around 8 hours to complete and learners will have 48 hours to complete the assessment and return it to NEBOSH.

RRC courses are now available for these, a remarkable job by our Course Development team, given the limited time they had to do this.

The new syllabi have 3 units each, with the removal of Unit DNI. The assessment is reduced to 3 assessments, an assignment and 2 case studies, all which can be completed at home or in the workplace, so no need to attend an exam centre.

There have been some significant changes in content but the most important is the removal of all content that was covered in the NEBOSH General Certificate. However, this content will still be examinable so it is important that learners have studied the General Certificate before starting on the new Diploma.

There is some new content but with the removal of the Certificate content, the notional learning hours are reduced to 335, plus a further 140 hours designated for the assessment. The structure of the new course is:

Role of Insurers, Leadership, Culture, Human Behaviour, Traditional versus Proactive Safety Management, High Reliability Organisation, Corporate Social Responsibility, Change Management, H&S in Supply Chain, Contribute to Legal Actions (ND only)

• Unit N/ID2- Based on Units B/IB content, it has been restructured and has around 15% new content added. New/ updated content includes:

Electricity / Use of Electrical Equipment, Construction Excavation & Demolition, Lone Working, Mental Health and Wellbeing, Health Surveillance, Health and Safety Monitoring

• Unit N/ ID3- Based on Unit C/IC content, it has been restructured and has around 10% new content added. New/ updated content includes:

Workplace Transport & Driving, Construction Excavation & Demolition

RRC courses will be available starting 1 June, but given the mammoth task in redeveloping the Diploma courses some methods of learning will not be available to early 2022.

## **New NEBOSH HSE Course**

The syllabus for this new 1 day course has been developed by NEBOSH in collaboration with the health and safety regulator for Great Britain, the Health and Safety Executive (HSE).

It is an introductory level qualification designed to develop straightforward, practical health and safety risk management skills to enable learners to go beyond risk assessment and help effectively control the health and safety risks caused by hazards in the workplace. It is designed for all involved in managing workplace health and safety risks including those who undertake risk assessments, including employers, managers, supervisors, SHE champions, and union and health & safety representatives.

RRC courses will be available for the end of June.

## **NEBOSH Resources**

If you are studying for a NEBOSH qualification, we would like to remind you that guidance from NEBOSH is available in the following publications, which can all be accessed from the 'Qualifications' area of the NEBOSH website (under 'Resources' for each relevant qualification):
