Choosing the right safety shoe



Choosing the correct safety shoe can be difficult – you need to make sure the shoe is not only appropriate and comfortable for the task being carried out, but also that it meets the regulations. Here are some tips.

Firstly you need to decide which job the shoe is for. The next thing to consider is PPE legislation – does it meet the standards? A steel or composite toe cap and enforced mid-sole is essential in most roles. If the job involves working in the cold make sure the boot is insulated. If the walking surface is likely to become slippery make sure the boot is anti-slip. If possible always buy a shoe with ankle support, especially if they are going to be worn all day.

Cleaning up Shanghai’s roadside air



With more than 4.2 million deaths every year due to ambient air pollution exposure, air pollution in China is a severe problem. From 2013 – 2017, the Shanghai People’s Congress activated a four year action plan ‘The Shanghai Clean Air Action Plan’ to address the issue.

The Shanghai Environmental Monitoring Centre has been working with Casella, air sampling, noise and vibration monitoring solution expert, to capture important air sample data in real time, vital in improving the health of the city.
