# CHSA 2019 Undergraduate Bursary winners announced

Two talented and hard-working young people – Maisey Woodisse and Timothy Young – have been named as the recipients of the **Cleaning & Hygiene Suppliers Association's (CHSA) 2019 Undergraduate Bursaries.**

for your support. It will allow me to pursue my ambitions at the University of Birmingham. I am beyond grateful for the generosity of the CHSA and the opportunity I have been given."

Tim said: "I enjoyed meeting the Panel and discussing my ambitions. The bursary will greatly help me with my studies at university. I am delighted to be a recipient and proud of your

trust and faith in me."
