ISO 14001 sets out the criteria for an environmental management system (EMS), mapping out a framework that organisations can follow to set up an effective EMS. It can be used by any organisation regardless of its activity or sector. Using ISO 14001 can provide assurance to company management and employees as well as external stakeholders that environmental impact is being measured and improved.

## ISO 14001:2015 Requirements Course

**ISO 14001:2015 Requirements** is a one day course that enables you to identify the structure and requirements of an effective environmental management system and what this means to you. You'll learn to interpret and apply the key concepts and principles of the standard to existing processes within your organisation.

The course is suitable for anyone in the planning, implementation, maintaining, supervising or auditing of an ISO 14001:2015 EMS.

**ISO 14001:2015 Requirements** content covers:

- Importance and benefits of an ISO 14001:2015 EMS
- Key requirements, terms and definitions of ISO 14001:2015
- Structure of ISO 14001:2015 which incorporates the Annex SL common framework management systems standards
- Main concepts such as the process approach, Plan-Do-Check-Act, lifecycle perspective, aspects and impacts

**Assessment:** There is no formal assessment for this course. A certificate of attendance is issued to those attending the course, and you will gain 8 CPD points.

## ISO Fundamentals of Auditing Course



This one-day course introduces learners to the fundamentals of practical auditing using the ISO 19011:2018 standard. The course will allow you to optimise your auditing skills to help you boost capabilities, gain confidence in planning and performing an effective audit (both internal and external), as well as reporting and taking corrective action where necessary.

### **BSI Fundamentals of Auditing allows you to:**

- Explain the guidelines of auditing, according to ISO 19011:2018
- Describe the application of these guidelines to auditing and therefore:
  - Initiate an audit
  - Prepare audit activities
  - Conduct audit activities
  - Prepare and distribute the audit report
  - Complete the audit
  - Perform the audit follow-up

**Assessment:** Upon completing the course you will be issued with a BSI Training Academy certificate.

## ISO 14001:2015 Internal Auditor Course

This one-day course teaches you the key principles and practices of effective EMS audits in accordance with ISO 14001:2015 and ISO 19011 "Guidelines for Auditing Management Systems". Using a step-by-step approach, you'll be guided through the audit process from initiation to follow up.

This will help you gain the knowledge and skills required to undertake a successful environmental management systems audit, and know how to plan, conduct, report, and follow up an EMS audit that establishes conformity and enhances environmental performance.

### **Prerequisite:**

To complete this course you need to hold a certificate in Fundamentals of Auditing, or pass the pre-course assessment to demonstrate you have the required level of knowledge.
