Assessment

Unit IG1 is assessed by an open book exam completed at home. Unit ICC1 is assessed by a two-hour written exam. Unit ICC2 is assessed by a practical assessment carried out at a construction site.

Exemptions

If you have been awarded the NEBOSH National [General](#) or [Fire](#) Certificate in the last 5 years you will be exempt from Unit IG1 and can simply 'top up' by completing Unit ICC1 and the practical assessment (Unit ICC2).
